Walpack Township

2010 Population = 16 people Land Area = 24 square miles

2010 Population Density = 0.67 persons/sq. mile

This municipal chapter is an element of the Sussex County Wastewater Management Plan prepared by Sussex County Planning Division in accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15.

## Existing and Proposed Wastewater Infrastructure

There is no existing or proposed wastewater infrastructure in Walpack Township. The vast majority of land in Walpack is Federally owned, part of the Delaware Water Gap National Recreation Area.

## Build-out in Septic Areas and DEP Nitrate Dilution Model

There is no current zoning ordinance in Walpack Township, and no land available for development. A Build-out analysis is not relevant for this parkland and was not done.

Note: This municipality was erroneously listed as an "Urban Municipality" by DEP. The definition uses criteria of less than 10% developable land, and Walpack erroneously was included.
