PROJECT STARTUP NOTICE

Project:

Advances the annual Sussex County Asphalt Long Line maintenance program which includes restriping Epoxy Lines on various sections of County Routes. On average epoxy long lines will provide 2-4 years of service life. Work will occur in various townships within Sussex County.

- 100% Sussex County Operating Funds
- Approximate Cost per Mile Epoxy: \$6,300.00
- Total Miles of Epoxy Restripe: 56 miles +/-
- Total Program Budget: \$350,000.00
