

COVID19 SYMPTOMS

In accordance with the County of Sussex's Policy on COVID19, in order to report to work and be present at work, employees must conduct a self-check of symptoms and not exhibit any of the following symptoms:

- Fever/Chills
- Cough
- Sore Throat
- Fatigue
- Shortness of Breath or difficulty breathing
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- New Loss of Taste or Smell
- Congestion or Stuffy nose
- Diarrhea
- Nausea or Vomiting
- Temperature that is 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit or higher

The County requires that its employees perform a self-check prior to leaving their home, and again, note their physical presentation upon arrival at work. In the event they are experiencing any symptoms noted above, they are advised to stay home and contact their supervisor and health care provider (or if at work, leave the workplace immediately, advising their supervisor).
